1 CULTURE

1.1 No Egos

No room for arrogance here! Our welcoming community is all about making real connections with other riders who share the same values and respect one another. So come join us – egos need not apply.

1.2 No Bad Attitudes

Looking for a good-natured challenge? You're in the right place – but if you want something extra intense, this might not be your cup of tea. Join us and show off those competitive chops while still having fun.

1.3 The One-Chance Rule

We're a no-nonsense, one-and-done kind of crew. We don't mess around when it comes to people who are on our team; succeeding in this series is all about making the right choices with whom you surround yourself. So, if someone isn't living up to those standards, they won't get more than that single opportunity – then it's time for them to hit the road.

1.4 Sportsmanship

Hard Enduro is not just a physical challenge, it's an emotional one as well. It takes grit and determination to endure this extreme sport – if you can complete even one lap around the course, you deserve a hearty pat on the back! Plus, your friends will be celebrating with beers all around. Good sportsmanship is key here – so don't sign up unless that's something you're down for.

1.5 Honesty, Integrity & Kindness

Being part of the WHES crew isn't just about having a good time — it's also about keeping each other accountable. We know that honesty and integrity are key for everyone to feel safe, secure, and supported in our community. 2 EVENT RULES

- 2.1 Please remember that events are held on private property. Please treat the property with care and respect.
- 2.2 All events are glass free. Please leave all glass containers at home including beer and wine bottles.
- 2.3 All events are smoke free. Please do not smoke.
- 2.4 No alcohol is to be carried or consumed outside designated licenced areas.
- 2.5 All electric machines or unregistered vehicles, other than those competing in the race, are not allowed on the race location. This includes but not exclusive to; e-bikes, e-scooters, pit bikes & Staycyc bikes.
- 2.6 Pedal assisted e-bikes are permitted at events as a mode of transport, but a helmet must be worn correctly.
- 2.7 Only one person per motorbike. No pillion passengers at any time.

3 REFUNDS

- 3.1 Refunds only. There are no transfers to other events.
- 3.2 In the event is cancelled each rider registered will receive a full refund of their One Event Registration fee of \$120.
- 3.3 A refund of \$100 for One Event Registrations will be given for the following reasons:
 - Entry withdrawn via email prior to close of entries at 8pm on the date entries close.
 - Entry withdrawn after 8pm on the date entries close via email supported by a Medical Certificate or Work Certificate.

4 SPECTATORS

- 4.1 Children must be always supervised. Children are not permitted in the pit areas.
- 4.2 No spectators are to enter the racetrack.
- 4.3 Spectators attending races do so at their own risk. Motorcycling is inherently hazardous and carries the potential for injury to both competitors and spectators, as well as damage to machinery. It's important to note that spectators are not covered by Motorcycling Australia's insurance scheme.
- 4.4 Spectators are required to sign in for emergency evacuation reasons.

5 BEHAVIOUR

- 5.1 Persons who use offensive or threatening language, cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with requests made by any WHES representative will be evicted.
- 5.2 Persons bringing personal items onto the event venue do so at their own risk. WHES and the landowner will not be held responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of personal property.
